Theory element (40%):

- The written exam is out of 80 marks

Practical Element of the course (60%):

- The practical assessments are graded from 0 – 25 in each activity, 25 being the best grade.
- Pupils must be graded in 4 activities. These grades are added to give a mark out of 100. This mark is then divided by 2 to give a mark out of 50 (50%).
- The coursework on Analysing Performance (PEP) is marked out of 10 and then added to the practical grade to give a mark out of 60. This grade is then doubled to give a mark out of 120.
